Literacy and Communication	Make a list of as many topic vocabulary words as you can. Find out the meanings of those words.	Write a play script retelling a classic fairy tale.	Think of a play you have seen or watch one if not. Write a review that could be published in a newspaper.	Write in role as an actor. This could be any genre that is suitable.	Research a famous playwright and write a biography of their life.
Maths and Problem Solving	Design a set for a play and research and price up how much it would cost to build.	Think of multi-step word problems related to our topic.	Research data linked to theatres e.g theatre capacity, ticket prices, profits. Make a graph to represent your data.	Draw a theatre to scale. Write the measurements and calculate the area and perimeter of each different space.	Make a maths game that is based on our topic.
Foundation	Find the famous theatre districts in the world and locate them on a map.	Create a map of the West End in London. Use ordnance survey symbols and include all the main theatres.	Survey people in your family to find out their thoughts on the theatre. What types of plays do they like? What are their preferences? Present your findings.	Research the history of the theatre. Find out how it began and how it has changed over time. Present your information in a form of your choice.	Create a Shakespeare timeline.
